PARK RULES

Persons who do not follow the rules are subject to removal from the park without refund.

QUIET HOURS: 11 pm to 8 am Michigan time.

SPEED LIMIT is 10 miles per hour on paved roads and NO DUST on unpaved trails.

DO NOT BRING FIREWOOD INTO THE PARK. Firewood is for sale at the store.

ALL ILLEGAL DRUGS INCLUDING MARIJUANA ARE PROHIBITED IN THE PARK.

<u>All vehicles and Golf Carts must register on arrival and display a "PASS" while in the Park.</u> **One vehicle may park on a site,** additional vehicles must park in visitors parking or in overflow areas. Only <u>licensed</u> drivers age 16 or older may drive a vehicle or golf cart inside the Park. See Golf Cart Rules below.

DO NOT PARK ON VACANT SITES, violators will be charged the daily rental fee for that site.

Utility trailers must be moved in "Storage Areas" and not parked on sites or in vehicle parking areas.

Persons under age 21 must be on their site by 11 pm or must be with their parent/guardian.

All persons must register on arrival. Persons under age 21 must register with parent/guardian.

Registered Campers are responsible for damage or injury caused by themselves, their children, their guests, and/or their pets. Be considerate and respect the rights and property of others.

Trails and paths around the lake and in the Pond area close at dusk. Game fields, playgrounds and beach area close at dusk.

Alcoholic beverages must be confined to the campsite. Intoxicated or disorderly persons will not be tolerated. Do not drink and drive.

Registered Campers are responsible for the cleanliness of their campsite and the recreation areas they use.

Clothes lines must be 6' above ground level and must be taken down when not in use.

State law prohibits dumping grey water on the ground, keep pail under sink drain and empty into dump station.

Washing of vehicles and campers/RV's is not permitted. Seasonal campers refer to the Seasonal Agreement.

These Items ARE NOT allowed in the Park.

<u>CHILDREN AND MINORS</u> - must not be left unattended in the park at any time.

- Persons under age 21 must be on their site by 11 pm or must be with their parent/guardian.
- Minor children must be supervised at all times everywhere in the park.
- Playground equipment is intended for kids age 12 and under.
- A fun place to draw with chalk is on the tarmac next to the pool area outside The Acorn Grill.

BICYCLES, SCOOTERS, SKATES, RIDE-ON DEVICES AND TOYS - We always encourage use of safety gear.

- Bicycles must have front and rear lights if being used after dark.
- <u>Skates, scooters, skateboards and like devices and ride-on toys are not permitted on roads.</u> All ages may use these type devices and toys on the "Kid Track" located next to the basketball court.
- Please supervise kids while going to and from the track and while they use the track.

PETS - We welcome friendly well controlled pets.

- All pets must be registered at the office. Bring pet vaccination record when you bring your pet.
- Pets must be on a 6' leash whenever outside the camper/RV regardless of their friendly disposition.
- Clean up pet excreta immediately no matter where it occurs.
- Do not leave pets unattended. Pets creating a disturbance may be removed from the Park.
- Do not chain or tie pets to trees, water risers, electric boxes, or fencing.
- Pets are not allowed in buildings, pool area, on playgrounds or beach except ADA compliant "Service Dogs."
- We are required by law to report biting incidents to local authorities.

GARBAGE – Campers must dispose of their trash.

- Dumpsters are located at the EXIT to the PARK. DO NOT BURN GARBAGE IN FIRE RINGS.
- Garbage must be bagged, tied, and disposed of in dumpsters.
- Cardboard boxes must be flattened.
- The following items cannot be placed in or around dumpsters: mattresses, furniture, appliances, grills, bicycles, rugs, carpets, and building materials -- YOU must remove these items from the Park for disposal, dumpsters are intended for household garbage and trash only.

FIRES - DO NOT BRING FIREWOOD INTO THE PARK. Firewood is for sale at the store.

- Fires must be contained in fire rings open fires on the ground are prohibited.
- Lumber with nails should not be used as fire wood.
- All fires are to be put out before retiring or leaving.

<u>GOLF CARTS</u> – Failure to follow golf cart rules may result in loss of golf cart privileges.

- Golf carts must be covered with a minimum of \$100,000 liability insurance, and a printed copy of proof of insurance must be on file in the office before the golf cart can be used in the Park.
- Only one golf cart allowed per site unless authorized by Park Management.
- Children may not drive golf carts. ONLY <u>LICENSED</u> DRIVERS AGE 16 AND OLDER MAY DRIVE IN THE PARK. <u>Drivers under age 21 MUST carry their driver's license while driving in the Park.</u> A "Learner's or Student Permit" is <u>not</u> a license.
- Golf carts must maintain "quiet operation" at all times. Gas powered golf carts must have a muffler.
- Golf carts must have head and tail lights when being used after dark. The use of a flash light is not an acceptable replacement for head and tail lights.
- Campers must charge or recharge electric golf carts on the meter at their campsite only.
- Golf carts must be driven on established roads and trails only and with the flow of traffic.
- Do not drive across grass fields and through playgrounds. Avoid driving on the beach unless providing someone with limited mobility access to the beach or boats.
- All passengers must be seated. No one shall stand or kneel on a moving golf cart.
- Drivers are responsible for driving in a safe and courteous manner at all times.
- Drivers must keep music volume and passenger voices at levels that do not disturb others.
- Golf Carts may not cruise or drive parade style around the park after 11 pm. Golf cart riding is not permitted after 12:00 midnight except to go to and from bathrooms.

<u>SIGNS, FLAGS AND LANGUAGE</u> – must be appropriate for everyone, young and old.

- Foul and/or profane language will not be tolerated from adults or minors.
- We will not allow the displaying of signs or flags we deem unsuitable for all campers.
- "For Sale" signs must be approved by Park Management before being displayed. Seasonal campers refer to the Seasonal Agreement.

<u>SWIMMING POOL and HOT TUB</u> – Pool area open from 10 am to 10 pm Memorial Day through Labor Day.

- NO LIFE GUARD ON DUTY SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- An adult who can swim must be with children under age 14 and non-swimmers.

- Only adults age 18 years or older are allowed in the hot tub. <u>Minors are not permitted to be in</u> <u>or sit with their feet in the hot tub.</u>
- Diving, running, pushing, and all roughhousing is prohibited.
- Persons who are ill or have injuries or open skin wounds are not permitted in pool/hot tub.
- Wash sand, dirt, and debris from feet and footwear before entering pool area.
- Shower with soap before entering the pool/hot tub to remove lotions and tanning oils. State law prohibits bathers from spitting in or otherwise contaminating pool/hot tub water.
- Only clean proper swim wear is allowed in pool/hot tub. Street clothes such as T-shirts, cutoffs, and cotton fabric clothing are prohibited.
- Life preservers, except those built into swim wear, are <u>not allowed</u> in pool. 'Swim arms' for small children are permitted and must be cleaned before use in the pool.
- Children who wear diapers must wear 'swim diapers' when in the pool.
- Flotation devices, inflatables, and all toys are prohibited in the pool area.
- Water in plastic bottles is the only beverage permitted in pool area. All other beverages are prohibited.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages in the pool area is prohibited. Do not use the pool/hot tub after consumption of alcoholic beverages.
- All food, snacks, gum, and food/beverage coolers are prohibited in the pool area.
- Glass, metal, or breakable objects or materials are prohibited in the pool area.
- Animals are prohibited inside the pool enclosure. ADA compliant "Service Dogs" are permitted but the dog may not go into the pool/hot tub.
- Dripping wet swim wear is prohibited in store, office, and The Acorn Grill.
- Pool lifts require a key which is removed to conserve battery power, ask for key at the store.
- Pool lifts are necessary to assist those with mobility needs <u>do not play, climb, or swing on the</u> <u>lifts.</u>
- DO NOT SIT OR HANG ON POOL ROPE SHOULD ROPE BREAK POOL WILL CLOSE.
